SCHEDULE ITEMS – No more than 2 entries per exhibitor per item.
All entries must be from exhibitor's own garden.

DEFINITIONS – DAHLIA

Giant (over 260mm)	DV – Distinct Variety
Large (210-260mm)	SS – Staged Singly
Medium (160mm-210mm)	AOV – Any Other Variety
Small (120mm-160mm)	DC – Distinct Colour
Miniature (Under 120mm)	CVA – Colour Variation Allowed
Pompom (55mm and under)	NND – Not necessarily distinct

Rules and Regulations

1. All exhibits must be entered in the name of the actual grower. Two or more growers may exhibit from the same property, provided each grower has a designated plot within the property.
2. On arrival, exhibitors must collect section cards from the Show Secretary for placing in the front of their exhibit.
3. Judges will not be permitted in show areas during staging of exhibits.
4. During judging, only judges and appointed stewards are permitted in the judging area.
5. Where tables are tiered, no other form of staging is permitted.
6. Exhibitors are asked to name all blooms.
7. On the relative merits of the exhibits, the decision of the judges is final.
8. All prize money is to be collected prior to the conclusion of the show, otherwise it will be deemed to have been donated to the club.
9. Should for any reason the show not be held, no exhibitor shall have any claim over the club.
10. All exhibits, so entered, become the property of the club until the conclusion of the show.
11. The Show Committee reserves the right to alter the show schedule if necessary.
12. The Show Secretary, along with the Show Committee has the right to refuse any entry from any exhibitor.
13. Leaves may be attached or added.
